## MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT SUPPLIES

The following is a list of supplies which are needed by each middle school student. The purpose of the supply list is to allow parents the opportunity of purchasing the needed supplies for their children before school begins. Please note that there may be an additional item(s) to obtain during the school year, per the teacher's request.

**Water Bottle:** Please bring a personal reusable water bottle (plastic disposable can be used.) Please put your child's name on any bottles he/she will bring to school.

**Personal Sanitizer Bottles:** Recommended types contain 70% alcohol. Please put your child's name on the bottle.

**Wipes:** 2 containers of wipes (Lysol or Clorox or any anti-viral version). Please put your child's name on the containers.

**TISSUES:** 3 boxes

**Book covers:** Please do not purchase the self-adhesive style. Be sure not to tape book covers directly to the back of the book.

**BIBLE:** All students will need a **ESV Bible** for normal Bible class. (*text edition 2016, not 2007*)

**BIBLE QUIZ** — **KJV bible**- Old and New Testaments (A Bible with concordance & cross reference is recommended.)

**PE CLOTHES (Grades 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>):** All 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students at UBCS will be required to have PE clothes. Non-marking athletic shoes are required footwear (no slip-ons). Loose-fitting t-shirts (not white) and loose-fitting shorts that cover the knee are acceptable girls' clothing. T-shirts and shorts or play pants are acceptable boys' clothing. (*You can wear on your PE day.*)

**MUSIC (5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grades):** All students need to have a pair of earbuds, labeled with their name in a ziplock bag (with their name on the bag as well). These will be kept in the music room and given to the kids when they need them. At the end of the year they will be returned to the students.

### **FIFTH GRADE: Put your name on binders/notebooks.**

- Blue Folder with pockets & Blue Notebook- Math
- Yellow Folder with pockets & Yellow Notebook- Reading
- Red Folder with pockets - English
- 1 composition books (wide ruled)-English
- Black Folder with pockets & Black Notebook- Bible
- Black Folder with pockets -Science
- 1 Purple & 1 Orange Folders with pockets – spelling/history
- Small Zippered Pencil Pouch
- (12) wooden #2 Pencils
- 2 soft pink erasers
- 2 Colored Pens (not black or blue)
- 2 expo markers
- 3 x 5 cards (1 pack of 100)
- Post-it Notes
- 2 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 3-ring binder (put folders in binder)
- Headphones with earbuds (no microphone)
- PE bag (draw-string variety is recommended)

**PLEASE: NO Permanent markers**

**Fifth Grade ART:** 1 pack of small sized carpet tacks for thread project and 2-3 (or more) colors of embroidery thread that you will want to use. & 1 x-acto knife. Any questions, contact Mrs. Myers at 267-274-9292.

### **SIXTH GRADE**

- 1-Three-ring binder
- 5 pocket folders
- 3 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- Math scratch pad
- Several red pens
- Several #2 pencils
- 1 colored pen (NOT red) for Reading class
- Small zipper pencil pouch
- 2 composition books
- 4 x 6 notecards
- For English: 3 x 5 lined notecards
- A basic 4-function calculator designed for elementary school use
- 4 different highlighters for English

**Sixth Grade ART:** 1 wooden tray for mosaics- only needs to be about 1/2 inch deep. Most are about 8x8. You can bring in glass pieces that you bought or bring ones you've broken yourself with adult supervision.

Last name starting with A-M: 1 pack (25-50 sheets) black card stock (Approximately 8 1/2 x 11")

Last name starting with N-Z: 1 pack (25-50 sheets) black card stock (Approximately 12x12")

\*\*\*\* N-Z: If you cannot get this size, get what you are able- like 8 1/2 x 11 or preferably larger\*\*\*\* Any questions, contact Mrs. Myers at 267-274-9292. **Please be sure to put your name is on each item. ## SEVENTH & EIGHTH GRADES

- 3-ring notebook(s) for 8 1/2" X 11" notebook paper (avoid those with worldly themes portrayed on them.)
- Notebook dividers with paper or a notebook for notes – **see below for specific class requirements**
- Pens (blue or black ink)
- Several #2 pencils
- Several pocket folders for papers returned by teachers
- **English:** 3x5 cards, folders for class papers, 8.5 x 11 spiral notebook, pencils, blue/black pens, 4 different colored highlighters
- **Life Science (7<sup>th</sup>) & Earth/Space Science (8<sup>th</sup>):** 2 notebooks: a homework composition notebook and a notebook/paper for note taking
- Red pens (for all MATH classes)

## MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT SUPPLIES cont.

- **Fundamentals of MATH:** TI-30 or better calculator is *REQUIRED* and the 30-XIIS is the suggested calculator. (The 30Xa will not work as well for HS Math, so investing in the 30XIIs is recommended.) No PHONE CALCULATORS or APPS will be allowed in class.
  - Pocket folder, spiral notebook for notes, 5x7 mini-spiral notebook to write down homework assignments, dry erase marker, and big pink eraser
- **Pre-Algebra:** TI-30 or better calculator is required and the 30-XIIS is the suggested calculator. (The 30Xa will not work as well for HS Math, so investing in the 30XIIs is recommended.) No PHONE CALCULATORS or APPS will be allowed in class.
  - Pocket folder, Dry-erase markers, pencils, A good eraser, a notebook for notes
- **Algebra I:** TI-30 or better calculator is required and the 30-XIIS is the suggested calculator. (The 30Xa will not work as well for HS Math, so investing in the 30XIIs is recommended.) No PHONE CALCULATORS or APPS will be allowed in class.
  - Pocket folder, Dry-erase markers, pencils, A good eraser, a notebook for notes
- **History:** journal/notebook for writing assignments
- **Bible:** 3X5 spiral index cards for 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> graders in Pastor Connors Bible class
- **STEM & BLOCK CLASSES:** Those details will be given in class.

**Art Classes:** 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grades

**7th-** Calligraphy/Typography/Design

- 1 pocket folder for notes and handouts
- 1 black Calligraphy marker 2.5 nib size- **a MUST have**
- 1 kneadable eraser
- 1 pad of nice quality watercolor paper

**8th-** Beginning Drawing

- 1 pocket folder for notes and handouts
- 1 medium range pencil set 4H-6B (Derwent is a highly recommended brand- avoid Artist Loft or Walmart brand if possible)
- 1 kneadable eraser
- 1 pad of smooth Bristol Board (8 1/2 x 11 or larger)
- 1 sketch book- optional- you may bring a used one OR draw sketches on plain paper and keep them in your pocket folder. Of course, you can always bring a new one- your choice
