Community

Upper Bucks Christian School is a private Christian school in the Southeast corner of Pennsylvania. It is located about 30 miles north of Philadelphia and about 15 miles south of Allentown. Upper Bucks serves the educational needs of students from various school districts including Central Bucks, North Penn, Palisades, Penridge, Perkiomen Valley, Quakertown, Souderton, Southern Lehigh, and Upper Perkiomen. Upper Bucks also ministers to students from various countries including Bangladesh, China, South Korea, Spain, and Vietnam.

School

Upper Bucks is a comprehensive preschool -12th grade Christian school that currently has about 300 students. The school has been in existence for over 50 years. Upper Bucks Christian School is a member of the Association of Christian Schools International and accredited through the Keystone Christian Education Association.

Curriculum

Upper Bucks Christian School teaches all subjects from a Biblical Worldview. For K-12, the primary curriculum is BJU Press.

The High School academic program at Upper Bucks Christian School is based on yearly credits.

AP® courses offered include Statistics and AB Calculus for in-person instruction and other AP options are available through online dual-enrollment. AP is an open-enrollment program.

Honors classes are offered in English, History, Math, and Science for grades 9-12.

Additional College Prep courses offered include Advanced Math, Algebra II, Anatomy & Physiology, Chemistry, and Physics. Business classes are offered in Accounting, Consumer Math, and Applied Math.

Graduation Requirements

Students are expected to take an average of 6.25 credits per year, and four year high school students should have 25 credits to graduate. The 25 required credits include 4 Bible, 4 English, 3 History, 3 Mathematics, and 3 Science credits.

GPA Calculation: Beginning with the 9th grade, all subjects are included in this computation. Grades are recorded on the transcript, and GPA is computed at the end of each school year. AP courses receive additional 20% for grade points and Honors courses receive an additional 10% for grade points on the GPA.
